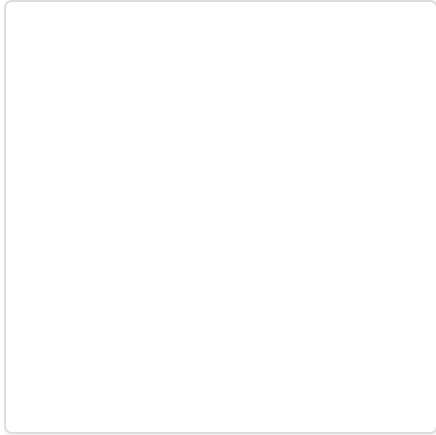




Albert Latendresse
