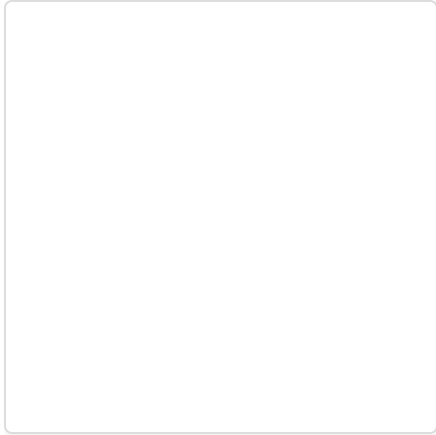




## Donald Borchert

OBITUARY Donald Gene Borchert, the son of Clarence and Annie (Hoium) Borchert, was born on August 22, 1928 in Hoffman, MN. He was united in marriage to Myrdene Froemming in Miltona, MN on September 30, 1950. Don moved from Hoffman, to Nelson, and then to Alexandria. Don was a member of Company K. 136th infantry regiment.
