



Douglas Dunn Nordmeyer

Douglas D. Nordmeyer age 88 of Alexandria formerly of Minneapolis died on Tuesday, April 21, 2015 at the Douglas County Hospital. A visitation will be held from 1-3 PM on Saturday, April 25, 2015 at the Anderson Funeral Home in Alexandria.

Douglas Dunn Nordmeyer was born on January 8, 1927 in Canby, MN to Charles Clarence and Mae (Dunn) Nordmeyer. He attended school in Canby until his sisters signed him up for the Navy at the age of 16. Douglas served in the Philippines and later worked in the California shipyards as a welder. Douglas met Marjorie Larson at the Naval Air Force Base in Minneapolis on a blind date. The couple was united in marriage on June 19, 1949 in Minneapolis. To this union the couple was blessed with 3 children. Douglas worked as a Minneapolis Police Officer and had many different ranks within the department. He retired as a homicide detective in 1984. The couple moved to Alexandria in 1989 to Lake Lobster to be closer to the lakes.

Douglas was an avid reader, enjoyed the lake boating and waterskiing, cross-country skiing, bicycling, motorcycling, and snowmobiling. He had a special place in heart for his dogs, and many times the daughters thought he loved the dogs more than them.

Douglas died on Tuesday, April 21, 2015 at the Douglas County Hospital at the age of 88. He is survived by his wife, Marjorie of Alexandria; daughters, Jill (John) Rieger of Minneapolis, and Jan (Bruce) Nordmeyer-Byers of Glenwood; seven grandchildren and seven great-grandchildren; and many nieces and nephews with a special relationship with nephew, Steve (Kim) Livingston. Douglas is preceded in death by his parents; son, Jeffrey; and sisters, Jean Livingston and Winnifred Pederson.
