Jane A. Boesen was born on January 25, 1936 in Howell, Michigan to Harold and Helen (Clark) Milette. She graduated from Howell Public School in 1955. After graduating, she worked at Spagnuolo's candy store. Jane moved with the family to Lansing. She then moved to Stillwater as a housekeeper at St. Michaels Catholic Church. Jane married Bernard J.
