Jeffrey Lynn Froemming was born on November 11, 1952 in Leaf Valley Township, Douglas County, Minnesota to Kenneth and Delrose (Ost) Froemming. He was baptized and confirmed at Ebenezer Lutheran Church in Leaf Valley and confirmed by Reverend William Moeller. Jeff attended school in Alexandria and graduated from Jefferson High School in 1972. He later went to work for F&M Plastics in Fergus Falls and then worked for Juno in Alexandria as a Quality Control Inspector until he retired in 1992 due to health reasons. Jeff loved the outdoors. In the spring and summer he loved planting and tending to his vegetable garden, which seemed to get larger and larger each year. He also enjoyed watching and feeding the birds. In the fall Jeff really enjoyed hunting and reloading shotgun shells for family and friends. Most of all Jeff was a family guy who thought the world of his boys. He loved being a grandpa and hanging out with his "Little Dudes". Jeff died on Sunday, May 18, 2008 at St. Mary's Hospital in Rochester at the age of 55.
