Jeffrey Marvin Wall was born February 21, 1954 in Comfrey, MN, the son of Marvin and Lucille (Windschittle) Wall. Jeffrey grew up in the Elbow Lake and Miliona, MN areas. He attended Jefferson High School in Alexandria. Following his schooling Jeffrey joined the United States Navy. After his discharge he returned to the Alexandria area. Jeffrey worked in the oil fields in Wyoming and later worked as a carpenter in the Alexandria area. He became a self-employed flooring installer, which he continued until becoming disabled in 2007.
