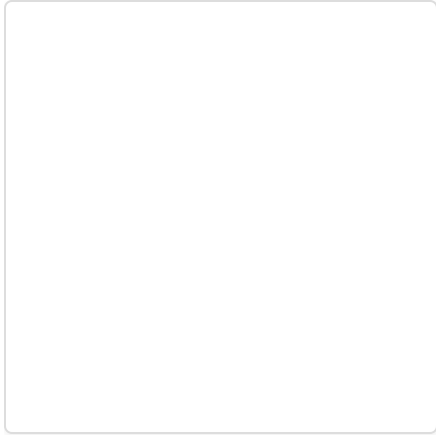




Lois Rudow
