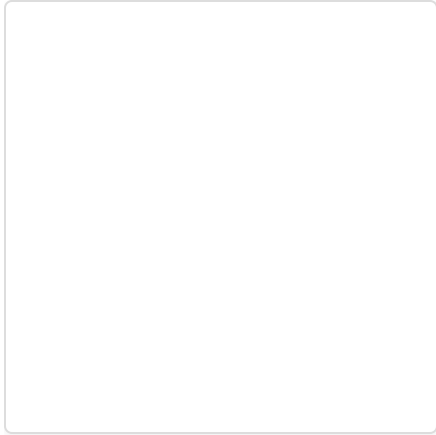




Mabel Klug
