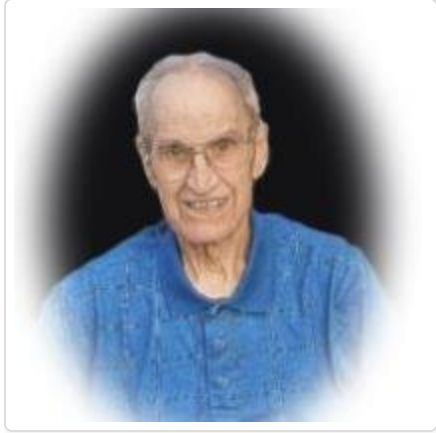




Paul Arvid Carlson

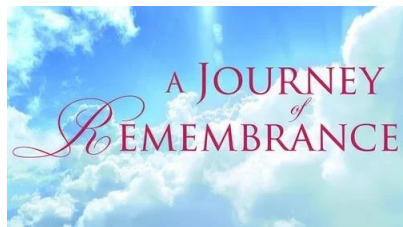
