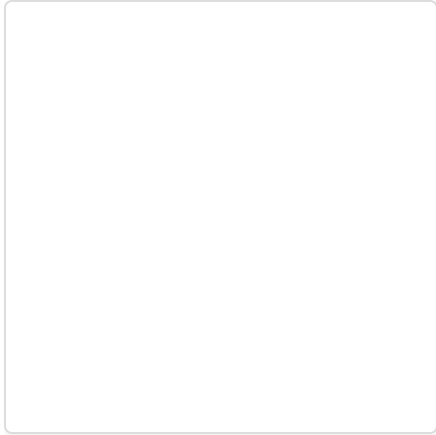




## Phyllis Mattocks
