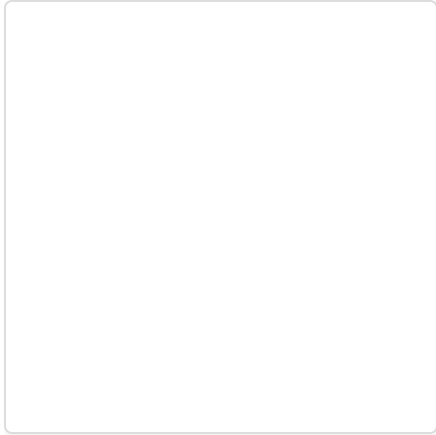




Steve Munn
